## **BRCA 1:10 Off-Road National – 5-6 June 2010**

### **Location**

Eden Park Raceway is located in the grounds of Club Langley, which is to the south east of London. ### **The Area**

Access to the capital takes around half an hour either by car or rail. Eden Park Railway Station is just a five-minute walk from the track providing a good service to central London. Bromley and Croydon offer excellent shopping centres and are less than ten and 15 minutes away respectively, with buses to both from stops outside of Eden Park Station. Locally, there are many restaurants within a few minutes of the track with West Wickham or Beckenham offering the best local evening entertainment.

### **Arrival**

EPR will allow access to the sports field from midday Friday. EPR officials will marshal access routes upon arrival meeting BRCA requirements and the necessity for emergency access. There is plenty of space available so please be considerate to others who may be arriving late or require access in and out of the venue throughout the weekend.

### **Venue**

The track is situated to the side of the clubhouse and faces the club's football pitches. Space between the track and the football pitches permits camping, caravans and motorhomes in defined areas. EPR officials will marshal access routes upon arrival. Club Langley will be charging £5 per night per caravan/tent – there is no need to pre-book caravan spaces. Those of you with generators will be asked to respect our neighbours, running them only between the hours of 7am and 11pm.

Food will be available from the Friday afternoon through to Sunday evening from the main clubhouse. The clubhouse offers bar facilities, toilets and showers, all available during the weekend. When the clubhouse is closed, there will be alternative toilet facilities available.

### **The Track**

The multi-surface track is the same one that was used so successfully in 2008 and 2009, although we will be incorporating a number of changes to some sections. The surface is primarily AstroTurf, but there is also tarmac and concrete sections adding to the undulating layout. The tyres to use in the dry are Schumacher Yellow Mini Spikes and whenever the track is wet or damp, we would recommend Schumacher Green Mini Spikes.

## Fast Food

## Directions

From M25 J7 – M23 North; A23 north towards London, Croydon & Coulsdon; Purley; A23 London & Croydon; Wing Yip Chinese Supermarket; traffic lights, turn right; A232 Croydon & Bromley; Central Croydon; A232 Sevenoaks, Bromley, Addiscombe; Addiscombe Rd; roundabout, turn right; roundabout, turn left, A232, Wickham Rd; McDonalds on right; next left, Monks Orchard Rd; roundabout, second exit; under railway bridge, turn right; Hawksbrook Lane; first gate on right; look for large EPR logo.

From M25 J4 – Head for A21 Bromley & Orpington; Roundabout, third exit, A21 Bromley; Pratts Bottom roundabout, second exit; A21 Bromley; Green St Green roundabout, second exit, A21 Bromley; roundabout, second exit; roundabout, straight across; second set of traffic lights, bear left onto A232, Croydon Rd; two sets of lights, straight across both, Coney Hall roundabout, second exit; West Wickham, traffic lights, turn right into Station Rd; traffic lights (swimming pool), straight across, Beckenham Rd; roundabout, third exit; under railway bridge, turn right; Hawksbrook Lane; first gate on right; look for large EPR logo.
